Approximately 8,000 square feet of vacant space on the second floor of a two-story warehouse. This building is currently used for college warehousing and storage, and sits on a 1.1 acre parcel with pedestrian access via the ground floor. A loading dock at the rear of the building provides direct access to the second floor tax-free area. The property is secured with a gated fence and a comprehensive security system including closed circuit television monitoring.
